

We will keep you informed, please read this information carefully.

- School Pupil Places—Please can I ask all parents to keep an ear to the ground for anyone who is looking for a space for their child at our school. We've had a number of families leave already or leaving soon for pastures new and we need to replace these children as soon as possible. We have space in Reception Class, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 & Year 5. - Church Cleaning Volunteers—The Church are looking for volunteers to help clean the Church. It will be done on a rota basis so you would do it once every 6 8 weeks, maybe longer if more people come forward. It only takes an hour. - Swimming— Year 3 will be swimming on Friday Mornings. All children need to be in school <u>before 8.45 am</u> when the coach leaves. Thank you.
- Fashion Haircuts—Please can I remind all parents that we have a very strict uniform policy which is clear on our high expectations regarding uniform, shoes and haircuts (See our website for more details). I have noticed a small minority of parents are ignoring our policy and having fashion haircuts which are too closely shaved to the skin or have a line shaved in as a parting. I would like to remind all parents that this is unacceptable. Thank you to all those parents who abide by our rules and keep their child's hair in a sensible and appropriate style for school. Punctuality – School starts at 8.50 am & closes at 3.20 pm Monday to Thursday. Every Friday it's open 8.50 am to 2.00 pm. Punctuality is important to ensure a good school day for both children and staff. **Security** – Once children have been dropped off at school they must not, under any circumstances, leave the school premises for reasons of Safeguarding. Pupil absence - If your child is absent from school please remember to phone school before 9.30 am. & send a note in when your child returns. **Uniform** – Please ensure that ALL school uniform is clearly labelled with vour child's name.

Dinner money – Please note this will increase to £2.35 per day (£11.75 per week) with effect from 30th April 2019. Please remember we are now 'Cashless' so all dinner money payments must be made via ParentMail.

School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.




Fashion Show & Clothing Sale Raffle Prize Winners!!!


