- New School Gates—Our new school gates are now operational. They have been installed to increase the level of security and safeguarding for our school and children. As we share the drive with the Church and Parish, the gates will only be locked during school hours which are Monday to Friday 7.00 am to 6.00 pm. During these times anyone wishing to enter the school site will have to press the buzzer to alert the school office and then they will open the gates as required. 

Punctuality – School starts at 8.50 am and closes at 3.20 pm Monday to Thursday. Friday 8.50 am to 2.00 pm. Punctuality is important to ensure a good school day for children and staff.

Security – Once children have been dropped off at school, they must not under any circumstances leave the school premises.

Pupil absence – If your child is absent from school please remember to **phone school before 9.30 am.** & send a note in when your child returns. **Uniform** – Please ensure that **ALL** school uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name.

Dinner money – This has increased from 24th April 2017 and is £2.25 per day (£11.25 per wk). Make cheques payable to 'City of Birmingham School Meals'. Please send dinner money on a Monday in a SEPARATE envelope to all other monies. School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.




