



Year 1



Autumn Term Plan

R.E.

This term we will be working on the following units: St Paul, our class saint. The story of Creation, Forgiveness, Prayer, Advent, and the Christmas Story.

English

Our English work this term will focus on narrative, poetry and non-fiction. Children will explore a range of books and carry out labelling, sequencing and narrative written tasks. They will cover narrative on the Gruffalo and fairy tales.

The emphasis will be on careful letter formation, sentence construction using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. The children will use 'and' and 'because' in their sentences to join their ideas.

Phonics

Children will revise and consolidate their learning of sounds already taught and begin to learn new sounds. They will practise blending sounds for reading and segmenting words in writing. Children will revise tricky words already learned and learn new sets of tricky words.

Handwriting:

This term the children will be learning the correct letter formation for the Caterpillar Letter Family: c, o, a, e, s, d, g, q and f. They will also learn the capital letter formation for these letters. Part of the handwriting work will also involve the children reading and recording words that begin with these letters. They will also attempt to construct simple sentences in these sessions to practise punctuation and their handwriting.

Spelling Punctuation and Grammar

This term the children will cover a variety of activities to help to develop their knowledge of:

- The alphabet
- Nouns
- Adjectives
- Alphabetical Order

Mathematics

- Finding 1 more and 1 less when given a number (up to 30)
- reading and writing numbers from 1-30 in order
- reading and writing numerals in words. (1-20)
- addition and subtraction (1-20).
- Find simple 'differences'
- Number bonds to 10
- odd and even numbers (1-20)



- time - in particular the days of the week, yesterday, today and tomorrow, months and years
- Counting in multiples of two and ten
- recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

Computing

This half term the children will learn how to log on, save, edit and print a piece of work. They will program a Beebot with instructions, to enable it to move around a map. They will also learn how to debug the instructions when the input is incorrect. This will enable the children to move to the next step of inputting code into a program on Purple Mash.



Science

We will be covering the unit of work: Animals including humans. We will cover the human body parts, animal body parts, the senses and we will learn how to group animals.

Art/Technology

The children will learn about the famous artist Monet and create their own London 'cityscape' using pastels and Sugar paper. They will design and construct models of London Landmarks.

Geography/History

In Geography and history children will learn about their school and the local area. In Geography children will learn about countries and capital cities of the U.K. They will also create their own simple maps.

P.E.

Multi-skills, running, throwing, catching and jumping skills.



P.S.H.E.

For P.S.H.E we will look at our relationships with others. We will use circle time to explore friendships, feelings, taking turns and sharing and rules in society.
