- Lateness—Please can I remind parents and children that school starts at 8.50 am. The gates are open at 8.30 am and the children can come into school for their SODA task from 8.40 am. Please make every effort to get to school before the gates are closed at 8.50 am. All children arriving after 8.50 am must be signed in at Reception using the new signing in system.

- Parking—I've had 4 complaints in the last 2 weeks of school!!! Please can I remind parents that you shouldn't be parking across, whether partially or fully, a dropped kerb entrance to our neighbours driveways; you shouldn't be parking on grass verges, it causes damage to the grass; you shouldn't be parking on corners or bends, especially on Tolworth Hall Road or Bracken Road, as it causes a lack of visibility for children and adults crossing; you shouldn't be parking on the ramped kerbs and tactile paving slabs (the studded ones on Tolworth Hall Road) as these are there to help disabled and blind pedestrians; you shouldn't be parking or stopping on the yellow zig zag markings outside school. Your support in this is greatly appreciated.
- **Swimming**—This half-term it will be the Year 4 group to go swimming. The children concerned have been informed. Please ensure they have the right kit and are here in time to get on the coach which leaves at 8.45 am every Friday. Please note, they will not be swimming on 14th February as this clashes with their Class Assembly.
- **Pupil Safety**—To ensure all of our pupils remain safe at the end of the school day NO CARS will be permitted to enter school via the driveway from 3.10—3.30 pm. Any vehicle entering between these times causes a concern for the safety of our pupils and parents who are crossing the drive to get out so as of Monday 20th January 2020 the gates will remain closed at 3.10 pm and will not open again until 3.30 pm. If you are a parent with a blue badge who uses the parking spaces by the Parish Hall, this means you will need to be here before 3.10 pm and you will not be able to leave until 3.30 pm. I hope you understand my reasons for this.



Punctuality – School starts at 8.50 am & closes at 3.20 pm Monday to Thursday. Every Friday it's open 8.50 am to 2.00 pm. Punctuality is important to ensure a good school day for both children and staff. **Security** – Once children have been dropped off at school they must not, under any circumstances, leave the school premises for reasons of Safeguarding. Pupil absence - If your child is absent from school please remember to phone school before 9.30 am. & send a note in when your child returns. **Uniform** – Please ensure that **ALL** school uniform is clearly labelled with vour child's name.

Dinner money – Please note this will increase to £2.35 per day (£11.75 per week) with effect from 30th April 2019. Please remember we are now 'Cashless' so all dinner money payments must be made via ParentMail.

School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.


