We will keep you informed, please read this information carefully.

- Fashion Haircuts—Please can I remind all parents that we have a very strict uniform policy which is clear on our high expectations regarding uniform, shoes and haircuts (See our website for more details). I have noticed a small minority of parents are ignoring our policy and having fashion haircuts which are too closely shaved to the skin or have a line shaved in as a parting. I would like to remind all parents that this is unacceptable. Thank you to all those parents who abide by our rules and keep their child's hair in a sensible and appropriate style for school. Thank you.
- Parking issues raising their head again!!! I have been contacted by Birmingham City Council who has informed me that a number of our parents are using the yellow 'School Zone' lined area as a drop off and pick up point. This is unacceptable and endangers the safety of others using the crossing. This particularly applies to those arriving by taxi. Please can you stop doing this and if you are arriving in a taxi, please can you instruct the driver to drop you elsewhere, not on the yellow lines. Thank you.
- Cakes in School—There is a tradition of parents sending in a small token of celebration for children to share with their classmates, usually sweets or lollipops. We have no problem with this but it is our policy to send these treats home so that you parents can see what it is and see whether or not you allow your child to have it. However, we have recently had some parents sending in a cake to be shared with the children. I do not feel this is appropriate as we have children in school with allergies and we have no idea what is in the cake, neither do the other parents. Plus, it is messy to transport and time consuming for my staff to cut up and distribute. So from now on, we will not be accepting or distributing and cakes sent into school for a child's birthday. I do hope you appreciate my standpoint on this.






