We wish to keep you informed about school issues so please read the following information carefully.

- Feast of the Ascension—Next Thursday 10th May, we will celebrate this special feast day when Our Lord's body Ascended into Heaven as a whole school community with Mass at 11.00 am led by Year 5. All are welcome.
- Year 3 First Holy Communion—The children of Year 3 will receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist on Sunday 13th May 2018 at 9.30 am. Details of the day have been sent out in a letter this week. 



Frequently Asked Questions

THE EVENT

Do I need to be super fit?

No. You can run, walk, crawl or cartwheel if you wish. This event is about having a fun filled day with family and friends. However if you wish to improve your fitness leading up to the event then why not join us every first Wednesday of the month, time TBC, then every Thursday 18:30pm – 19:30pm at The Crown, Tyburn Road for a fitness session/bootcamp (£4 per session). Keep an eye on our Facebook page for further information and updates 'SSPP Fundraising Page'.

Can I take photos or film at the event?

Snap away! We welcome anyone to photograph or film at our event for PERSONAL use only. If you are having too much fun to bother taking any pics, don't stress we will also have a photographer taking various pictures on the day to capture the action.

Where can I leave my belongings?

There are no locker facilities on site so we suggest you leave your valuables at home, with spectators or in your car. Parking is available, however may be limited due to the number of participants expected.

Can spectators attend?

Yes – The more the merrier, entry will be a donation. Food and drink will be available on the day along with various activities that spectators can get involved with. So spectators are more than welcome to come along to support your team and watch the fun.

Can I enter individually or do I have to enter as a team?

No, you can enter individually and we will allocate you a team to go around the course with on the day.

REGISTRATION

What is included with my entry fee?

An amazing day of fun, dirt, laughter and fundraising.

Is there an age limit for younger runners?

Children aged 3 years upwards are allowed to participate in this event. Children under 10 years old must be accompanied around the course by an appropriate adult (over 18). Participants aged 10 years -18 years will not need to be accompanied around the course however a parent/guardian must be present/on site at all times. Parental/Guardian consent is required for all participants under the age of 18 years.

Am I able to receive a refund?

Unfortunately, we cannot issue refunds. The logistics of setting up and planning the event mean that entry fees will be offset against this. You are welcome to transfer your registration over to someone else. Just ensure they have the completed entry form and appropriate consensual signatures if required.

SPONSORSHIP

How does this work?

As this is a sponsored event every participant is being asked to raise as much sponsorship as possible (ideally a minimum of £50 per family). Sponsor forms are available from Kristina/Kelly.

THE COURSE

How far is it from start to finish?

We are super casual but we do know that the Hollyfield's is spread-out over 9 acres of land. Don't worry about that, just enjoy the experience.

How many obstacles/activities are there?

More than 10; less than 10,000. Feel free to count as you go around.

Can I bring my scooter or bike?

Unfortunately due to safety reasons, it is advised that these not be brought along.

Will I get dirty?

Honest answer, yes most likely and you will probably get wet too. We suggest you wear clothing and shoes that either you are happy to scrub, or happy to chuck away afterwards.

What if an obstacle is too hard?

The obstacles have been designed to challenge you but we also want you to enjoy the day. If you need to go around an obstacle that's fine (you may get team penalty point though...).

CHARITY

Is this for charity?

Yes SPFA is a Registered Charity in England and Wales, Charity No. 1172005. All funds used will be used to improve the school playground.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Is there insurance?

Your entry fee provides limited insurance cover, under a public liability scheme, however your entry conditions also include acceptance of the waiver.


