We will keep you informed, please read this information carefully.

- Parents Evenings—Thank you to all of the parents who turned up for their appointment this week to discuss their child's progress and behaviour in school. It is always a valuable exercise, spending quality time discussing a child so thank you to everyone who took this opportunity. Both nights were extremely well attended as always! Thank you. I also thank all of my staff for their hard work and preparation for these appointments ensuring that parents get accurate and honest information about their child. Well done.
- Parents Questionnaires—At Parents Evening, you will have been given a copy of the parent questionnaire asking for feedback on a number of areas of school life that concern you and your child. Please can I ask that you fill them in and get them back to school asap. I need to collate all responses and use them to inform future school improvement planning. Thank you.
- **Lenten Charities 2019**—This year the children have chosen to support the following charities in their fundraising: Global Charity - WE, National Charity - Fr. Hudson's Society, Local Charity - John Taylor Hospice. Each class has organised their own fundraising events which they have completed this week. I would like to say a massive thank you to all of our fabulous parents and children for all your support, I will let you know exactly how we much we have raised when all of the sponsorship has been collected.
- **Swimming**—Year 3 will be swimming on Friday Mornings after Easter. They all need to be in school **before 8.45 am** when the coach leaves. Thank you.
- Fashion Haircuts—Please can I remind all parents that we have a very strict uniform policy which is clear on our high expectations regarding uniform, shoes and haircuts (See our website for more details). I have noticed a small minority of parents are ignoring our policy and having fashion haircuts which are too closely shaved to the skin or have a line shaved in as a parting. I would like to remind all parents that this is unacceptable. Thank you to all those parents who abide by our rules and keep their child's hair in a sensible and appropriate style for school. Thank you.
- Parking issues raising their head again!!! I have been contacted again by Birmingham City Council who has informed me that a number of parents are using the yellow 'School Zone' lined area as a drop off and pick up point. This is unacceptable and endangers the safety of others using the crossing. This particularly applies to those arriving by taxi. Please can you stop doing this and if you are arriving in a taxi, please can you instruct the driver to drop you elsewhere, not on the yellow lines. Thank you.

School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.




