- New buzzer system for Leading Light Club—To ensure that our children are as safe and secure as possible while they are in our care, we have changed the timings of the gates to make them lock after school too. There is now an additional buzzer on the left-hand side of the pedestrian gate which is solely to access the Leading Light Club in the Parish Hall. The original buzzer is now solely to access school. I hope you appreciate the steps we've taken to ensure we keep our children as safe as possible. Thank you.
- Late Collection of Children at the end of the school day—We have a few families who, for a variety of reasons, are late collecting their child from school at the end of the day; after 3.20 pm. Just to let you all know that I have amended our school policy to include the following information which will take effect immediately from Monday 10th September: If your child is not collected by 3.45 pm, they will be taken over to Leading Light Club in the Parish Hall and you will be charged £8.00 per child for the session. 




### **SPFA Reception Family Welcome Disco**
