

GENERAL INFORMATION

Punctuality – School starts at 8.50 am and closes at 3.20 pm Monday to Thursday. Friday 8.50 am to 2.00 pm. Punctuality is important to ensure a good school day for children and staff.

Security – Once children have been dropped off at school, they must not under any circumstances leave the school premises.

Pupil absence – If your child is absent from school please remember to phone school before 9.30 am. & send a note in when your child returns.

Uniform – Please ensure that ALL school uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name.

Dinner money – This has increased from 24th April 2017 and is £2.25 per day (£11.25 per wk). Make cheques payable to 'City of Birmingham School Meals'. Please send dinner money on a Monday in a SEPARATE envelope to all other monies. School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.


