



NEWS

We wish to keep you informed about school issues so please read the following information carefully.

- Year 6 Leavers Production—Due to unforeseen circumstances, I have had
 to change the date of the leavers production to Wednesday 18th July @
 6.00 pm. It was scheduled for the Tuesday. I hope this does not cause any
 problems for parents, sorry.
- **Sickness**—As important as good attendance is, please make sure that if your child is genuinely ill and has vomited, our policy is that the child needs to be clear of sickness for 48 hours to ensure they do not pass anything on to others in school, causing them to have time off too. It is better to have one child off for 2 days than have 10 children off for more days. Thank you.
- Haircuts—Please can I remind people of our strict policy regarding haircuts!
 We ask that parents ensure that their child's haircut is of a reasonable and
 sensible style for school, avoiding fashionable or extreme haircuts. It should
 not be shaved too short and be blended so there are no distinct steps or
 lines shaved into it. Thank you for your support with this.
- Leave during term time It is important that you remember, only in exceptional circumstances will leave during term time be granted, this does NOT include holidays. The amount of time taken for holidays during this academic year (4th September 2017 to 25th May 2018) totals 159 days of children missing from school. This is a total of 31 weeks and 4 days of your children missing lessons and their vital education.
- Year 6 Confirmation Prayer Service for Parents—Thank you to all those Y6 Parents and family members who turned up for the prayer service this morning, it was great to see you all there. I know that our children are well prepared for tomorrow when they meet the Bishop.




