**Punctuality** – School starts at 8.50 am & closes at 3.20 pm Monday to Thursday. Every Friday it's open 8.50 am to 2.00 pm. Punctuality is important to ensure a good school day for both children and staff. **Security** – Once children have been dropped off at school they must not, under any circumstances, leave the school premises for reasons of Safeguarding. **Pupil absence** – If your child is






