

Uniform – Please ensure that ALL school uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name.

Please send dinner money on a Monday in a SEPARATE envelope to all other monies. School Dinners – If your child changes their meal pattern from School dinners to packed lunch or swap from pizza day to packed lunch we must insist on half a terms notice. Thank you.


